A taste of sublime

TILL February 1, 10.30 am-7.30 pm: In Hindu and Buddhist philosophy, Moksha means salvation. A MokshaShot (by artist Jenny's Bhatt's own definition) is a taste of the sublime. Everyone can make their own MokshaShot out of anything they may find fulfilling — art, chocolate, a holiday, a smile, a Ferrari or even a tequila shot! This series of paintings, titled Moksha Shots Episode 12: The Conquest of the Mind, uses satirical humour to comment on social and cultural practices prevalent today. It examines the internal and external entities that strive to conquer the mind. The series hopes to provoke a closer look and change in perception of the times we live in. The works are

multi-layered with irony, social and cultural references. The MokshaShots series was first exhibited in Mumbai in 2008 and Jenny has further explored this concept. She has also created a range of art multiples based on her paintings: limited edition art prints, T-shirts, iPhone cases, notebooks, playing cards, mouse pads, coasters and Art Toys. These will be up for sale at the exhibition too. Art Toys are limited edition collectibles or figurines based on the MokshaShots.
